From Principal's Desk



Vivekananda College, P.O.: East Udayrajpur, Madhyamgram, North 24 Parganas, Kolkata – 700129, was established in 1986. It is named Vivekananda College to pay our homage to Swami Vivekananda, the great patriot and social reformer, and eternal embodiment of the soul of India and a great inspiring force behind the making of Modern India.

Our college is a co-educational, Day, General Degree College affiliated to the West Bengal State University. It is situated in a calm and quiet atmosphere and is far from markets, stations, cinema halls and other disturbing factors. At the same time it is within the locality where all Modern Amenities are available. It stands on the Eastern side of the Jessore Road, National Highway No. 34, about 1 KM from Madhyamgram Chowrasta & 2KM from Madhyamgram Railway Station on Sealdah-Bongaon section. It is about 18 kms away from Central Calcutta and is connected with the city, the capital of West Bengal both by bus routes and train services.

The college has now its own building (Three-storied, one-storied) and Three-storied Women's hostel, canteen for students and staffs, surrounded by boundary walls. The college has also constructed an open stage, guard wall of the garden. A new feather in our cap was added with the purchase of more than 6 kottahs of land adjacent to the main building. This additional land will be a great asset for the college & go a long way in solving the problem of space and additional infrastructural development. At present the college offers 11 Honours courses viz. Bengali, English, Political Science, History, Philosophy, Education, Journalism and Mass Communication at B.A. (U.G. Level) and Geography, Physics, Chemistry (General), Mathematics, Computer Science, Physics & Geography at B.Sc. (U.G. level). Further, the college authority introduced M.Sc. in Geography, M.A. in Bengali and M.A. in Education at Regular P.G. level. Distance Education has also been introduced in a number of subjects at U.G. level viz. Bengali, English, Political Science, History, Education, Mathematics, Public Administration, Library & Information Science under NSOU (Netaji Subhas Open University) and 9 subjects at P.G. level viz. Bengali, English, History, Political Science, Public Administration, Education, Journalism & Mass Communication, Library & Information Science, and Mathematics under NSOU. Besides P.G. Diploma in Advertising and Public Relations is also offered under NSOU. Apart from these courses we also have a Learner Support Centre (LSC) affiliated to DDE Rabindra Bharti University in Bengali, History and Education. The College has also introduced Computer Training

Centre in collaboration with WEBEL Technologies. The University Grants Commission gave us the approval for implementing the Computer Application Diploma Course. Career Counselling and Placement programmes are carried out on regular basis through ICICI Academy, George Telegraph, Techno India, IIT Kanpur, Pune Institute of Business Management, RICE, Gillette Proctor and Gamble, Orion Edutech and various other Career counselling organizations for grooming our students and also offer jobs in various corporate sectors. WBCS Training as well as power-point presentation skills are enhanced for the benefit of the students. The NET/SET/JRF/National Fellowship qualified students and Teachers guide our students on regular basis for appearing in these examinations successfully.

100% students of Honours course pass the final examination with good marks and a large number of students obtain first class marks. 16 students have also passed the NET, SET, JRF examinations conducted by NTA and The West Bengal College Service Commission. 2 students have joined as Assistant Professors in Govt. Aided colleges of West Bengal. 2 students have cracked WBCS and more than 70 students joined jobs in various Government and corporate sectors in the last year. Some students and Teachers have obtained their Ph.D. degree, more students as well as teachers are perusing their Ph.D. in various Universities.

The college presently has 34 classrooms. Besides, 23 AC machines have been installed, smart classroom, virtual classroom and a fully furnished seminar hall with Wi-Fi connection & sitting accommodation for 150 participants. 50 CCTVs and 8 solar lights around the college ground have been set up. 4 Water Coolers/purifiers, 3 Aqua guards have been installed for hygienic drinking water for the students and all the Stakeholders. An open-stage has been built. 6 fully equipped laboratories, a large library room, reading room, Departmental Seminar libraries have been successfully set up for the students. Fees are collected from the students via online by Bill Desk. Inflibnet system, E-library, LMS systems, Online Career Counselling systems, Online Feedback systems for all the stakeholders have been prepared successfully.

At present the student strength of our college is about 4500. All the facilities provided for the students - free Wi-Fi internet facility, gym, digitalised books, nearly 15000 books are there in the library. Students' stipend and concession facilities are there. The total course fees is very low and India Today Magazine has announced our fees structure to be the 3rd among 10 lowest fees taking colleges in India in 2021-22.

The institution has been accredited with 'A' Grade in the First cycle by NAAC on 2016 & 'A+' Grade in the 2nd Cycle by NAAC on 2023. The college got nominated as Social Media Champion by MHRD in 2019. We have successfully got ATAL Ranking in 2020-21 as "Band Performer" among the Non-Technical colleges of India. We have also procured Swaach-Bharat certificate. India Today magazine

(published on 4th July, 2022) ranked our college as 8th among the top 10 best emerging colleges in India, 5th Best Science College and 5th best Arts College in the Eastern Region. We have also procured 2nd Place in Kolkata in Arts among the best colleges of the city. We have also ranked as the 68th College in Arts and 63rd college in Science among the best 171 Arts colleges and 186 Science colleges in the country. We also have received the ISO certificate. Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan has been started in the college and 5 villages under Kemia Khamarpara Gram Panchayat have been undertaken by our college to prepare them as model villages. We have also successfully taken pledges like : Data Safety, Cyber Safety for Women, Road Safety, Human Rights, Anti-Dowry, Yoga, 'Mahatma Gandhi in me', Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav etc.

Presently there are 44 Faculty Members and 21 Office-Staffs. More than 30 teachers have obtained their PhD degree. Most of the teachers are publishing their papers in various renowned National and International Journals (enlisted in the UGC Care List) on regular basis. Some teachers have also written books which have immensely helped the students.

More than 60% minority community students are taught in this college along with many 1st generation learners. 58% girl students have been admitted to our college. Many of them are rank holders in the West Bengal State University. Our college has signed MoU with various Academic Institutions viz. Many Colleges, Madhyamgram Municipality, various NGOs and many Job oriented, Career Counselling Institutions for mainly job oriented courses. The college has introduced various Add-on courses, Computer Literacy programmes through WEBEL. The academic atmosphere in the college campus is peaceful, calm and quite. The ambience is very student friendly. Classes of Communicative English is organised on regular basis by the College Authority.

Our founder member Sri Saral Deb, former Minister, W.B. Govt., established the college in 1986. After that Sri Rathin Ghosh, former President of the Governing Body and presently Minister in Charge, Food and Supply Dept., Govt of West Bengal whole heartedly participated in the all-round development of the institution. Presently Sri Nimai Chandra Ghosh, is the President of college Governing Body. Dr. Rimi Roy has assumed the post of Vice- Principal since February, 2024. With efforts of all the stake holders the college has progressed from the standard of a Primary school to the much coveted NAAC accredited 'A' Graded institution in 2016-2021 to NAAC accredited 'A+' Graded institution on and from 2023.

It is expected that with copious funds from the Govt. of India, the college will perform the onerous responsibility of catering to the needs of the villages adopted.

ADMISSION REGULATIONS

For

**B.A. / B.Sc. (Major / Minor) based on credit frame work of
National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**

Admission Qualifications

A candidate who has passed the “10+2” standard is eligible to seek admission to the First Semester of the Eight Semester B.A./B.Sc. (Hons.) or in the First Semester of the Six-semester Multidisciplinary B.A./B.Sc. The course of studies provided she has also passed in English with full marks not less than 100.

No candidate, in general, shall be allowed for admission in the course after a lapse of more than 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. The desirous applicant requires prior permission from the University authority. Students desiring admission to 3-year Multidisciplinary programme shall get a total lapse of not more than 6 years.

The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

In exceptional cases a candidate may be allowed for admission after 3 years of the previous qualifying examination, but, within 3 years after discontinuation of a recognized regular Course of Study.

Determining the eligibility for admission in the 4-year Honours Course, aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks of the top four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate at the “10+2” qualifying examination. However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies shall not be considered for calculating the aggregate marks. If the subject “Environmental Science” is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

Determining eligibility for admission to the 3-year Multidisciplinary UG programme of study will be the same as above.

Eligibility to apply for a Course

A candidate taking up Honours or Multi-Disciplinary Programme must have obtained:

A minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject or related subject at the previous qualifying examination. In the case of Music (Hons.) 45% marks in the aggregate and 45% marks in the subject Music in the previous qualifying examination or 55% marks in the subject or related subject in the previous qualifying examination or 50% marks in the aggregate when the candidate has not studied the subject in her previous qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe category must have obtained 40% marks in the aggregate and 40% marks in the subject/related subjects at the previous qualifying examination (10+2 level) for being eligible for admission in the Honours programme of study.

Candidates applying for Multi-Disciplinary Course must have passed each subject & a minimum qualifying number in "10+2". Candidates willing to take Computer Science as General Subject must have passed Computer Science in the "10+2" standard. Candidates applying for Mathematics (Minor) she should have passed in Mathematics at the "10+2" level examination.

Students, who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) examination or its equivalent from all India Boards/Councils or State Boards/Councils including Open Schools and vocational studies, are eligible for study at the UG level.

Students who have passed "10+2" from All India Boards/Councils (viz. CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling) are not required to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

Students who have passed "10+2" from All India Boards/Councils (viz. CBSE, ISC and National Institute of Open Schooling) are not required to submit the Migration Certificate for getting Registration under this University.

Any dispute regarding eligibility criteria would be resolved by the Equivalence Committee set up by the University or by the Executive Council in its absence.

The candidate (Foreign Nationals) will have to show "Original Copy" of Certificate of Madhyamik (or equivalent), Certificate of Higher Secondary (or equivalent) and original Passport (along with Student Visa) at the time of admission. Foreign Nationals will have to pay the fees five times higher than the Indian Nationals. Their papers must be duly endorsed by the local Embassies/Consulates/High Commissions, whichever is applicable and their visa period must cover the period required to complete the course.

Choice of Courses

4-year UG (Honours) Course of Studies: Candidates will have to choose a single major discipline and any two minor disciplines along with the requisite numbers of AEC, SEC, MDC & VAC along with an internship. The combination of major and two minor disciplines for the students admitted in 4-year UG (Honours) will be decided by the college authority.

*[**Nomenclature of degree will be notified later on communication from UGC.]*

3-Year Multidisciplinary Undergraduate (UG) programme of study: A candidate is required to choose any three subjects from one or two broad categories of disciplines as offered by the concerned college. She will be awarded a 3-year B.A./B.Sc. in a particular discipline provided that at least two out of the three subjects chosen by her falls in that particular category.



MORE ABOUT THE NEW CURRICULUM AND THE FUNCTION OF OUR INSTITUTION MAJOR AND MINOR DISCIPLINES

Major discipline is the discipline or subject of main focus and the degree will be awarded in that discipline. Students should secure the prescribed number of credits (about 50% of total credits) through core courses in the major discipline.

Minor discipline helps a student to gain a broader understanding beyond the major discipline.

Multidisciplinary Course (MDC)

All UG students are required to undergo 3 introductory-level courses relating to any of the broad disciplines given below. These courses are intended to broaden the intellectual experience and form part of liberal arts and science education. Students are not allowed to choose or repeat courses already undergone at the higher secondary level (12th class) in the proposed major and minor stream under this category.

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC)

Students are required to achieve competency in a modern Indian language and in the English language with special emphasis on language and communication skills. These courses aim at enabling the students to acquire and demonstrate core linguistics skills, including critical reading and expository and academic writing skills, that help students articulate their arguments and present their thinking clearly and coherently.

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC)

These courses are aimed at imparting practical skills, hands-on-training, soft skills to enhance the employability of the students.

Value Added Course (VAC)

These are courses that will help develop all capacities of human beings – intellectual, aesthetic, social, physical, emotional, and moral in an integrated manner. Each of these courses carries 3 credits.

Internship

The internship is intended to provide opportunities for students to actively engage in on-site experiential learning. The student has the option to complete a 2-credit summer internship in a lab, industrial organization, R & D lab, or through community engagement, NSS, NCC as organized by the college. The student must complete a 2-credit summer internship by his/her 5th semester of study. Our college provides the best of the options in this respect in association with top NAAC-rated Colleges and esteemed Institutions.



Credit Hours for Different Types of Courses

- ✂ The workload relating to a course is measured in terms of credit hours.
- ✂ Each course may have only a lecture component or a lecture and tutorial component or a lecture and practicum component or a lecture, tutorial, and practicum component, or only a practicum component.
- ✂ Per week a one-credit course in practicum or lab work, community engagement and services, and fieldwork in a semester mean two-hour engagement. In a semester of 15 weeks duration, a one-credit practicum in a course is equivalent to 30 hours of engagement.
- ✂ A one-credit of Seminar or Internship or Field practice/project or Community engagement and service means two-hour engagements per week. Accordingly, in a semester of 15 weeks duration, one credit in these courses is equivalent to 30 hours of engagement.
- ✂ A course can have a combination of lecture credits, tutorial credits, and practicum credits.
- ✂ **Lab- based Subject**
Theory-3 credits (45 Hours); Practical-2 credits (30x2=60 Hours), Tutorial-1 credit (15 Hours).
- ✂ **Non Lab- based Subject**
Theory-4 credits (60 Hours); Tutorial-1 credit (15 Hours), Field Work-1 credit (30 Hours).

Duration of the Programme

The duration of the UG programme (Honours) is 4 years or 8 semesters. Students who desire to undergo a 3-year UG Programme will be allowed to exit after completion of the 3rd year. Students may be permitted to take a break from the study during the period of study but the total duration for completing the programme shall not exceed 7 years. The duration of Multidisciplinary UG Programme is 3 years.

Qualification Levels & Credit Requirements

For 4 years UG Honours minimum credit requirement is 180, whereas, for 3 years multidisciplinary programme the minimum credit requirement is 125.

Post- Admission Stipulations

The college has the freedom to hold any number of tests and examinations of their own students in the form of class tests or preparatory tests or open-book tests whatever may be required for the betterment of the students.

It is expected that the semester examinations will be held every six months as per the academic calendar which will be duly intimated in advance by the University.

Academic Calendars and Academic monitors are prepared by every department to ensure academic accuracy and accountability. Under the supervision of Academic subcommittee academic accounting is done on regular basis to assure quality in transmission of knowledge to the students. Completion of syllabus by the faculty members within the stipulated time and continuous evaluation, remedial classes and classes for the advanced learners are scheduled to upgrade the quality of teaching learning. Internal examinations are also mentioned before the commencement of the academic session.



Re-Admission

In case of discontinuation of Studies, the candidate concerned can be permitted only fresh admission with the issuance of new Registration (in cancellation of the earlier registration) after submission of an affidavit from a 1st class Judicial Magistrate that he/she has not taken admission under any other University/Institution in the intervening period. All such 15 cases of fresh admission have to be preceded with the cancellation of earlier registration. For all such re-admission the provisions of this regulation in consonance with the Act and Statute of the University and the guidelines issued by the West Bengal Higher Education Council from time to time should be followed. However, after an exit at the end of the 3rd year after completion of stipulated 6 semesters, the candidate will not have to re-register if he wants to complete the course within 7 years from the date of exit.

College Transfer

*Transfer of candidates from one affiliated college to another will be possible as per the provisions laid out in the regulation of NEP 2020 based CCFUP system which will be in force at the relevant time. However, in all cases such transfers will be effected after due approval of the application of the candidate concerned along with requisite non-refundable fees to the University administration without contravening the provisions of the Regulation in force. **All applications for transfer have to be made to the University authority within 30 consecutive days of commencement of the relevant semester. The applications must also contain the attendance of the student in that semester. The University reserves the right to approve or reject such applications of transfer and it cannot be treated as a matter of right on behalf of the applicant concerned.***

The college is committed to provide pure drinking water through deep tube-well and Blue star cooling water purifier machine both in College Main Building and Hostel Building and Canteen.





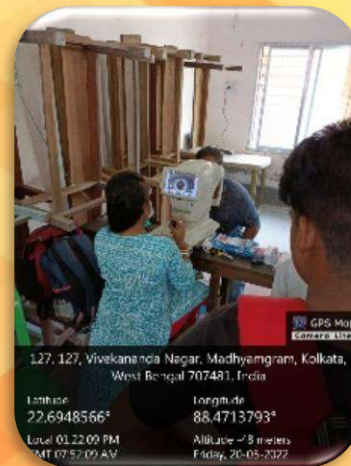

Library and Library Rules

Library store the energy that fuels the imagination. They open up windows to the world and inspire us to explore on achieve and contribute to improving our quality of life.

The Library of Vivekananda College has emerged to its prominence by introducing modern amenities for the students, teachers & scholars. It boosts by digitization, Wi-Fi zone, INFLIBNET & Bar coded system. Regulations for Library users:

- ✂ The Library hours from Monday to Friday from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on Saturday from 11:00 A.M to 2:00 P.M. The Library has the reading room facilities for more than 30 (thirty) students can use the reading room at a time. Books are issued on submission of requisition slips on all working days except Saturday between 11:00 A.M to 2:00 P.M.
- ✂ Every student will provide a library card on submission of admission slip at the beginning of the session which will entitle him/her to borrow a book from the library for a stipulated period. The Library card is not transferrable and has to be returned within a fortnight before the student sit for his/her final examination or when the students take transfer. In case of loss, a fresh card will be issued on payment of a fee of Rs. 20/- (Rupees twenty) only.
- ✂ Only one book will be issued to Under Graduate students and two books for Post Graduate students at a time and can be retained by him/her up to 15 days. Re-issue is permissible provided the books are not needed by other students or not in short supply for the reading room. Reference books may not be taken out of the library reading room.
- ✂ Books must be returned before or on the due date, failing which a fine of Rs.2/- (Rupees two) only per day will be charged for each book for each day of the default. If the fine accumulates up to Rs. 20/- (Rupees twenty) or more, the students will not be allowed to take out any book till the fine has been paid and the Library official has granted him/her permission to use the Library.
- ✂ If the book is lost it must be replaced or borrower should pay the market price of the book.
- ✂ Online Journal and e-books through N-List are accessible for all users.
- ✂ The borrower shall have to check as to whether the book issued to him/her is littered, damaged or moth eaten at the time of issue. No complaint in this regard shall be considered thereafter.
- ✂ Taking, sleeping, smoking and loitering within the library are strictly prohibited.

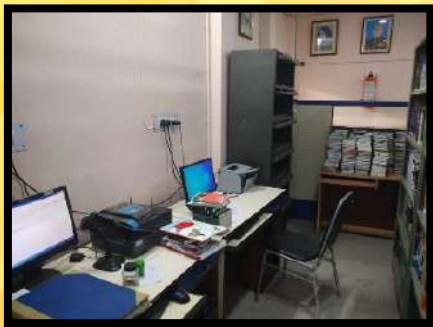
